James St. Aubin Scholarship  
2012**

Background: This scholarship, in the amount of \$1,000.00 was created by the membership of Disney-Bell Post 66 in memory of Past Commander St. Aubin.

Eligibility: Any senior NJROTC cadet at Bowie High School planning to continue their education at an accredited 2 or 4 year college /university.

Application Procedures: Senior NJROTC cadets competing for this scholarship must submit the following documentation no later than April 30<sup>th</sup> 2012.

Application packet will consist of:

1. Cover page providing:
  - Full Name
  - Address
  - Phone number
  - SAT /ACT scores
  - College / University acceptance letter (if available). A list of schools applied for if final decision has not been made.
  - A one paragraph explanation of personal and college goals.
2. High School transcript showing GPA and total hours of community service from Bowie High School.
3. A 1 page resume of the Cadet's leadership positions, training, awards, and accomplishments while enrolled in the NJROTC program
4. Endorsement letter from a current NJROTC instructor.
5. A 500 word essay discussing how the NJROTC program has prepared you to succeed in life.

Selection: A selection board will be held by the Americanism, Children & Youth subcommittee, Disney – Bell Post 66. The Board's recommendation will be presented to the May 2012 General Membership meeting for approval. Winner will be notified by letter after the final selection.

Award: A check will be issued in the winner's name to the college or university of their choice. If the Cadet selected accepts an appointment to a federally funded academy, Disney – Bell Post 66 will award scholarship to the runner up.

Presentation: Winner will be recognized at a Disney – Bell Post 66 event and announced in the local news paper (press release from parent/guardian required).
